The structure is designed to meet the needs of first aid operators, civil protection teams, and ambulance personnel.

The **40-liter** internal architecture is characterized by total operational flexibility: the main compartment has **removable and adjustable dividers**, allowing the space to be configured based on the type of intervention kit. The integrated transport system represents a distinctive element, allowing rapid transition from hand or shoulder mode to **backpack mode** via retractable shoulder straps, ideal for interventions in inaccessible areas or for long distances on foot.
