



Urban furniture information lectern for inground installation h287_267

Galvanized steel information lectern for public spaces. 40x40 cm panel with transparent plexiglass, Ø40 mm tube structure, non-toxic painting, for inground installation. H.120 cm.

The information lectern is an element of urban furniture designed for spaces of cultural and architectural interest. Ideal for open-air museums, archaeological excavations, and historic centers, it allows for the display of historical and cultural descriptions, geographic maps, and informative material in an orderly and readable manner.

The structure combines **robustness and durability**: made of Ø 40 x 1.5 mm galvanized round steel tube, subjected to treatment to remove impurities and coated with **non-toxic painting** that resists atmospheric agents and wear over time. The display panel, made of **20/10 thick galvanized steel sheet**, is covered by a **transparent plexiglass sheet** that protects the contents while maintaining their readability.
